The Distributed Education Instructional Designer/Facilitator reports to the Director of Educational Research and Development and, under the supervision of the Distributed Education Team Leader, provides instructional design expertise, facilitates and supports appropriate use of learning technology at Camosun College. The principal responsibilities of the position are to ensure that a high standard of instructional design is maintained throughout the life of each online learning development project and to design and facilitate workshops and other development activities for College faculty and staff. The successful candidate must be able to work in a team environment and be detail-oriented with the ability to write proposals and manage projects within deadlines and budgets.

The successful candidate will be responsible for:

- Direct face-to-face and online learning strategy support for faculty engaged in teaching using web-based educational technologies.
- Instructional Design of courses and programs using Desire2Learn and other web-enabled e-learning technologies.
- Ensuring the instructional integrity of course/program development projects through a systematic design, development, implementation and evaluation process.
- Developing and delivering face-to-face and virtual training for faculty in the processes of teaching and learning using web-based technology including Camosun College's Learning Content Management System, Desire2Learn (D2L).
- Fostering the appropriate use of learning technology by developing and implementing support mechanisms for learners and faculty.
- Promoting the sustainable and effective use of web-enabled learning technology through communicating, organizing and facilitating events, and other activities as required.
- Contributing to the development and implementation of policies, procedures, and guidelines relating to instructional design, curriculum design and educational technology.

- Conducting and/or coordinating research as appropriate in the following areas:
 - Curriculum design as related to learning technology
 - Educational effectiveness of technology
 - Funding and other resources
 - Writing requests for proposals on internal and external projects.
- Performing other related duties as may be required from time to time.

Qualifications:

- A Master's degree in a related field plus three years of experience in the area of learning technology, instructional design, project management, workshop development and facilitation or an equivalent combination of education and experience.
- A working familiarity with learning-related technologies and current instructional and curriculum design approaches.
- Experience teaching and/or experience providing support to faculty, curriculum developers, or trainers at the College level.
- Experience in project management, including managing time, establishing priorities, distributing responsibilities, and meeting milestones and deliverables.
- Knowledge and experience using Desire2Learn, Camosun's Learning Management System.
- An ability to relate well and effectively with team members, other colleagues, and learners.
