Two Full-time Continuing Faculty Positions Commencing September 2010

The Centre for Sport and Exercise Education at Camosun College requires **two** full-time, continuing faculty members (*one position pending funding approval*) in the Sport Management diploma program and the Sport & Fitness Leadership degree program. This position is responsible for developing and teaching curriculum aimed at academic and field work aspects of professional preparation for sport and fitness related careers.

The successful candidate will be responsible for:

- Developing and teaching courses in the field of sport and fitness leadership and/or sport management with specific expertise in one or more of the following areas:
 - Sport and fitness facilities management
 - Sport and fitness marketing
 - Sport and fitness leadership
 - Sport and fitness management
 - Physical activity – team/individual sports
- Assisting in the coordination of various activities for the Sport Management diploma and Sport & Fitness Leadership degree program, including:
 - Facilitation of student learning and student success
 - Ensuring adequate resources for program courses taught
 - Undertaking some development of new courses, as appropriate
 - Mentorship and guidance to program support staff
- Disseminating information about sport and fitness related topics to diverse audiences including public agencies, sport and fitness professionals, colleagues, researchers, lay audiences, and others; through the use of a variety of teaching techniques and delivery strategies
- Conducting applied research and publishing findings in peer-reviewed journals for both academic and practitioner audiences
- Working as a team member with Pacific Institute for Sport Excellence (PISE) partners including scientists, administrators, coaches, and instructors on relevant projects and goals
- Providing expertise and contributing to the Pacific Institute for Sport Excellence's community programming and services

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Master's degree with an emphasis in sport and organizational leadership, socio-cultural aspects of sport, sport management, applied sport coaching/instruction or related areas;
- Recent practical experience in a variety of sport-related settings;
- Demonstrated effectiveness in teaching in off-campus settings,
- Ability to work as a team member to build and maintain a collaborative atmosphere;
- Excellent written and oral communication skills, including the ability to communicate effectively with community groups;
- A variety of current sport and/or fitness relation certifications.

- PhD with an emphasis in sport facilities management, sport and fitness marketing, sport and fitness management
- Experience in setting-up and managing sport and/or other community-based programs;
- Ability to conduct applied research;
