



Course Supply List

Basics of Acrylic Painting

Course: ASCE 415G

Approximate Cost \$120.

Supplies may be purchased from local Art Supply stores (not Camosun Bookstore).

(Note: Some local art supply stores may provide a discount if you show a receipt or/and this Supply list for the course – please confirm with store.)

- Sketchbook
- Graphite pencils (for exploring your ideas before you paint, and for notes). A HB, 2H and 2B will be adequate. The HB is a mid range dark, the 2H is good for initial sketching as its very light, and the 2B is good for laying in your darks.

Painting Surfaces:

- Water-colour paper: A book 12"x16" or larger or 3 large sheets that can be cut down.
- 2 painting canvas: suggested size: 12"x16" or larger

Acrylic paints:

(You can start with tubes of a student quality)

- Ultramarine Blue
- Cadmium Yellow
- Cadmium Red
- Titanium White
- Paynes Gray
- Alizarin Crimson
- Medium Violet
- Pthalo Green
- Pthalo Blue
- Burnt Umber

Brushes for Acrylic Paints: Flat tipped Synthetic or Hogshair

- Suggest one larger (a #6 or so), one medium size (#4) one smaller size (#2) and a round watercolour brush for detail work (#6)
- Acrylic Gel Medium (regular/semi gloss)
- Acrylic Gesso
- Palette knife
- Palette of some kind for mixing your paints on (wooden painters palette, or a tin tray, or even tin foil)
- Small spray bottle for keeping your paints moist

It is not recommended to purchase any supplies too far in advance of your course start date. Courses can be cancelled due to low enrolment or other unforeseen problems. Camosun College is not responsible for supplies you have purchased.
