University Transfer Studies at Camosun towards a **BACHELOR OF ARTS (BA)** at the University of Victoria per 2009/2010 UVic Calendar

Students take required and elective courses to complete their first and, if applicable, second year of university studies as outlined in the Camosun College Courses boxes below. Camosun College courses have pre and/or co-requisite requirements that must be met before entry into each course.

A Letter of Concurrent Enrolment (**LOCE**) is required when specified for course work not offered by Camosun College.

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITY:

Students taking course work at Camosun, or other post secondary institutions, must confirm admission and program requirements, course selection, deadlines, & GPA requirements with their destination institution. Students are advised to discuss any potential pre-requisite requirements for 300 or higher level course work with the destination institution.

ELECTIVES:

Elective courses must carry transfer credit to UVic. See Camosun College Academic Advisors to learn how to use the BC transfer guide to check course transferability. Elective courses may be at the 100 or 200 levels from any of the subject areas listed in the following boxes:

GEOGRAPHY

Years One and Two

- ENGL 150
- GEOG 100, 102, 216, 220, 222, 232
- 2 non-GEOG Social Science courses
- 2 Humanities, Science, or Other electives but not GEOS
- 9 electives (Recommend GEOG 210, 214 **and** 1 of GEOG 204 & 206 **or** GEOS 100 & 110 **or** GEOS 110 & GEOG 206)

HISTORY

Years One and Two

- ENGL 150
- 4 of: HIST 100, 102, 103, 104, 106, 108, 110, 112, 120, 122, 202, 204, 206, 214, 230, 232, 235, 250
- 15 electives

LINGUISTICS (Applied)

NOTE: Students who meet high school admission requirements to UVic are recommended to apply directly to UVic as Camosun does not offer all of the required first year course work for this program.

Year One

- ENGL 150, 160 **or** 164
- 2 CHIN **or** FREN **or** ITAL **or** JAPN courses at 100 level (see Advising for other language options)
- PSYC 110 **and** 1 of: PSYC 120, 130, 150, 164
- **UVic:** LING 100A (See Advising for **LOCE**)
- 3 electives

PACIFIC and ASIAN STUDIES

Note: Students apply to UVic for Year 2.
All language courses require a minimum "B" in each.

PHILOSOPHY

Years One and Two

- ENGL 150

- 2 PHIL courses (PHIL 100, 102 recommended)
- 15 electives

POLITICAL SCIENCE

Years One and Two

- ENGL 150
- 4 PSC courses at the 100 or 200 level which must include:
 - 1 of PSC 104 **or** 106 and
 - 2 from PSC 104, 105, 106, 210, 220, 222
- 15 electives

SOCIOLOGY

Years One and Two

- ENGL 150, 160 **or** 164 (combined minimum average "B")
- SOC 100, 101, 220, 280
- 14 electives (MATH 116 recommended)
