University Transfer Studies at Camosun towards a **BACHELOR OF COMMERCE (BCOM) at UVIC** per 2010-2011 calendar

Students take required and elective courses to complete their first and, if applicable, second year of university studies as outlined in the Camosun College Courses boxes below. Camosun College courses have pre and/or co-requisite requirements that must be met before entry into each course.

A Letter of Concurrent Enrolment (**LOCE**) is required when specified for course work not offered by Camosun College.

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITY:

Admission to the program is competitive. Universities use a variety of evaluation tools to assess admission. Check your destination institution website for details.

Students taking course work at Camosun, or other post secondary institutions, must confirm admission and program requirements, course selection, deadlines, & GPA requirements with their destination institution. Students are advised to discuss any potential pre-requisite requirements for 300 or higher level course work with the destination institution.

ELECTIVES:

Elective courses must carry transfer credit to the destination institution. See Camosun College Academic Advisors to learn how to use the BC transfer guide to check course transferability. Elective courses may be at the 100 or 200 levels from any of the subject areas listed in the following boxes:

Years One and Two

- ECON 103
- ENGL 150 and 1 of ENGL 160 or 164
- MATH 109, 216
- 15 Arts and/or Science electives: Recommend BUS 130, COMP 156 or BUS 140, ECON 104, 205, HLTH 110, MATH 108, PHIL 210, 330, SOC 100. Recommend 2 from FREN, CHIN, JAPN, ITAL, KORE if heading towards International Business Specialization

FYI: UVic accepts maximum 4.5 units of commerce transferable course work. Do not take: BUS 220, BUS 230, FIN 210, or MARK 110
