University Transfer Studies at Camosun towards a **BACHELOR OF ARTS (BA) – PSYCHOLOGY** or a **BACHELOR OF SCIENCE (BSc) – PSYCHOLOGY or BIO/PSYC** at the University of Victoria per 2010-2011 UVic Calendar

Students take required and elective courses to complete their first and, if applicable, second year of university studies as outlined in the Camosun College Courses boxes below. Camosun College courses have pre and/or co-requisite requirements that must be met before entry into each course.

A Letter of Concurrent Enrolment (**LOCE**) is required when specified for course work not offered by Camosun College.

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITY:

Students taking course work at Camosun, or other post secondary institutions, must confirm admission and program requirements, course selection, deadlines, & GPA requirements with their destination institution. Students are advised to discuss any potential pre-requisite requirements for 300 or higher level course work with the destination institution.

ELECTIVES:

Elective courses must carry transfer credit to UVic. See Camosun College Academic Advisors to learn how to use the BC transfer guide to check course transferability. Elective courses may be at the 100 or 200 levels from any of the subject areas listed in the following boxes:

 - BIOL 100 & 102 or BIOL 124 & 126
 - COMP 156 or BUS 140
 - 1 of MATH 100, 108, 109 or PHIL 210
 - 1 PHIL
 - Humanities electives
 - 2 from ANTH, ECON, GEOG, PSC, SOC

- PSYC 110 and 1 of PSYC 120, 130, 150, 164
- PSYC 201, 210, 215
- 10 electives – recommend the following degree completion requirements
 - COMP 132 or 156 or BUS 140
 - 1 of MATH 100 or 108 or 109
 - 1 PHIL
 - 4 Science electives from the same subject area
 - 2 Science electives
 - 2 from ANTH, ECON, GEOG or PSC, SOC

Years One and Two

- BIOL 124, 126, 230
- CHEM 120, 121, 230, 231, 255
- ENGL 150 and 1 of BUS 130, ENGL 160, 164 or 165
- PSYC 110 and 1 of PSYC 120, 130, 150, 164
- PSYC 201, 210, 215
- 5 electives – recommend the following degree completion requirements
 - 1 of COMP 156 or BUS 140
 - 1 of MATH 100 or 108 or 109
 - PHYS 104 & 105 or PHYS 114 & 115
 - 1 electives
