



## Co-op & Internship Photo Contest 2009

### Purpose of Contest

The Co-operative Education & Student Employment department is pleased to announce its annual photo contest, which showcases co-op or internship students applying their education in the workplace. Photos and accompanying information will highlight student work experiences and will be used to promote academic programs at Camosun College as well as offer the students the opportunity to share their work experiences with each other.

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** Submission of photographs to the co-op photo contest gives Camosun College permission to publish, exhibit, play, transfer and otherwise use the photos for marketing, administrative and educational purposes.

### Eligibility

To be eligible, Camosun College students must have registered in a co-op or internship work term course any time between **October 1, 2008 through August 31, 2009**, and photographs must pertain to a work term within this time period. Final awarding of prizes is contingent upon the winners successfully completing their work term with a passing grade. Students interested in entering the contest who are unsure if they are eligible should contact the co-op office to verify. All entrants must submit an entry form.

### Photographs

Students may submit a maximum of three digital photos. The photos should show the student in a co-op or internship work environment. Each photo submission must include a brief description (50 words or less) explaining what you are doing in the photo. Digital photos should be high quality full size images, 2 mega pixels or more, with a file size of approximately 1 MB. Digital photos must be submitted in JPEG format. Visit [www.pixlr.com/app](http://www.pixlr.com/app) for a good on-line photo editor. You can open a photo in it, resize and edit, and save it back to your disk. It all takes place over the internet without any need for special software on your computer.

### Categories

#### 1. *Student@Work* Prize: \$500 Camosun College Gift Card (approximate value of one work term tuition)

As this contest is running across all co-op and internship programs offered in the Schools of Arts & Science, Business, Trades & Technology and Centre for Sport & Exercise Education, a main prize for each school/centre will be awarded. The *Student@Work* prizes will be given out based on the finest representation of a co-op or internship student at work within their particular industry. The 1<sup>st</sup> prize winners for each school will receive a \$500 Camosun College gift card, the approximate equivalent value to the co-op or internship work term tuition. Ladies and gentlemen, the *Student@Work!* prizes are for **the best of the best** in each school.

2. Peoples' Choice Prize: \$250 Camosun College Gift Card

In addition, all photo-projects will be put on display during *CAMFestival* – the student welcome event hosted by Camosun College in September. Camosun College students will have the opportunity to vote for their favorite photo. The photo that receives the most votes will win the *Peoples' Choice* Prize and the winner will receive a \$250 Camosun College gift card.

3. Fun, Funky & Fabulous Prize: \$50 Camosun College Gift Card

Finally, 4 additional prizes will be awarded for photos that are fun, creative, unique and/or artistic. Winners will each be awarded a \$50 Camosun College gift card.

<b>Student@Work</b>	\$500 Camosun College gift card (the approximate value of one work term tuition). One prize awarded for each school/centre.
<b>Peoples' Choice</b>	\$250 Camosun College gift card One prize awarded
<b>Fun, Funky &amp; Fabulous</b>	\$50 Camosun College gift card Four prizes awarded.

**Note:** Limit of one prize per student.

For your convenience, photos will be accepted throughout the year. You will receive confirmation of your entry. The final submission deadline for all entries to the contest is **Wednesday, August 12, 2009**.

Judging

The contest will be judged by the director of Co-operative Education and Student Employment and the co-op and internship coordinators for the Schools of Arts & Science, Business, Trades & Technology and the Centre for Sport and Exercise. Winners will be announced on **September 30, 2009**. Winners will be contacted directly by phone and results posted on the co-operative education website.
