Date: **Spring 2012.**

Cost: **\$3-4,000 – includes travel, housing, meals, tours, tuition**

Course: **DH 262 Clinical Theory And Practice Course**

This 4 week program offers students the opportunity to fulfill partial credit for their DH 262 Clinical Theory and Practice course.

While studying abroad, students will participate in promoting oral health through educational sessions at schools in the area, perform oral health screenings to over 300 school children, and perform dental hygiene services in the hospital and makeshift clinics.

The students will be given opportunities to live, work, and play with the locals through community events and activities. Visits to local attractions are included in the agenda.

The last two weeks of the course will be completed on-campus. The on-site coordinator, supervisor and instructor will be a faculty member from the Camosun College Dental Hygiene Program.
