Purpose of the Challenge

To enable the industry, as well as observers, to view the level of skills taught within the public secondary and post-secondary education system, and to encourage interaction between the various sectors. This relationship will help ensure that the skills gained by hairstylists at all levels of training are geared towards the demands of the beauty industry.

Skills & Knowledge to be tested

The level of this competition will allow the stylists to demonstrate their technical skills and creative ability in the following tests:

Test #1 Ladies Creative Day Cut and Style with Color Enhancement

Test #2 Ladies Hair by Night with Non-Hair Ornamentation

No written test will be administered. The theoretical knowledge will be relevant in the performance of the practical tests.

Test #1: Ladies Creative Day Cut and Style with Color Enhancement

- 4 hour time limit.
- Mannequin may be pre-colored using **ONE** color technique. For example, competitor has a choice of complete solid base color, bleach, or foil.
- During the competition all color techniques are allowed.
- The choice of color is free.
- A maximum of three colors permitted.
- No color sprays, gels or mousses are allowed.
- Mannequin may be pre-cut however a minimum of 1" **MUST** be cut during the competition.
- The style is of the competitor's own choice.
- Competitors must perform a blow dry on wet hair.
- All styling tools and products are allowed with the exception of color sprays, color gels or color mousses.
- Wigs, hairpieces and bobby pins are not permitted.
- Jewelry, clothing and make up on mannequin are permitted provided they are not in the hair.

Test #2: Ladies Hair by night with Non-Hair Ornamentation. The competitors will use the creative style from test #1 to transform into hair by night with the addition of longer hairpieces and ornamentation.

- 1.5 hour time limit.
- The mannequin from test #1 remains on the floor unchanged
- Prior to the start of the competition scrutinizers will check if there is a minimum of 2 hairpieces to a maximum of 3 hairpieces
- The competitor must thoroughly brush the whole head when given the order
- This competition is an elegant evening style.
- Competitors can, if they wish, wet, shape, blow dry or style the hair
- No hair cutting permitted. Only texturizing the ends of the hairpieces on the finished style is permitted (no change to original style of cut from test #1)
- Longer hair must be integrated in order to emphasize the fashionable evening character, but also in order to present a new longer appearing style (including 2-3 hairpieces)
- Mannequin may be pre-colored using any color/technique prior to competition (coloring not permitted during competition).
- Hair may NOT be pre-set, curled or styled.
- All styling tools and products are allowed with the exception of color sprays, color gels or color mousses.
- Ornaments made from hair or hair-like fibers are not permitted.
- Ornamentation MUST NOT cover more than 25% of the whole head.
- Jewelry, clothing and make up on mannequin are permitted.

Safety Instructions

Competitors must demonstrate aptitude in safety awareness.

*Please note that first aid attendants will be available.

Equipment, Tools, & Materials

The following materials must be supplied by the contestant:

- 10 towels
- 2 female mannequins
 - One mannequin may be pre-colored using ONE color technique. For example the competitor has a choice of a complete solid base color, bleach or foil
 - One mannequin may be pre-colored prior to competition
- Chemical Colors
- Bowl and brush (or applicator bottle)
- Color remover
- Styling Products
- Shoulders and Drapery (or clothing and jewelry – not mandatory)

- Own make-up for touch up only (make-up for mannequin pre-done)
- All styling/working tools
- Clips
- Cutting Tools & Razors
- Blow Dryer
- Curling & Flat Irons
- Ornamentation for evening style

Judging & Distribution of Marks

All judging will be performed according to the 30 Point International System. Further information on the 30 Point International System can be found at <http://omchairworld.com/>

Demerits will be given for any rule infractions.

Any communication between audience and competitor during contest times may be seen as coaching and could result in demerits.

No head sets, walkmans, portable CD players, or iPods allowed.

No technical support such as formulas, pictures, drawings, notes, etc.
