ROBERTA J. PAZDRO AWARD

CRITERIA FOR ELIGIBILITY

Students must apply for this award.

The Roberta J. Pazdro award is named for "Rob" Pazdro, co-editor of Not Just Pin Money: Selected Essays on the History of Women's Work in British Columbia and long time production manager in the Canadian film and television industry in Toronto. This award is given to one or more students who do special work on the subject of women in British Columbia or Canada.

To be eligible to receive this Award, the student must fulfill these requirements:

- Completion of the first three academic semesters of Applied Communications, graduating in that year.
- Production of a significant project as part of an ACP course assignment in any medium on the subject of women in BC or Canada.
- Demonstration of career interest in media.

Complete and submit an application form available from the Arts & Science office (F104A). Submit the application, the above information and the project to the **Applied Communication** office (Young building) by the deadline noted below.
