CRITERIA FOR ELIGIBILITY

Students must apply for this award.

The Indigenization Essay Award is awarded to a student who has written an outstanding paper addressing an issue that provides insight into Indigenous issues in Canadian society.

To be eligible to apply for the Indigenization Award, students *must*

- submit a 50-word abstract and an essay of up to 2,500-words on an issue that provides insight into Indigenous issues in Canadian society.
- essay may be part of an essay submitted for marks in any course in the School of Arts and Science.
- submit a clean, typed document and include a title page.
- complete and submit an application form available from the Arts & Science office (F104A).
