CRITERIA FOR ELIGIBILITY

Students must apply for this award.

This award is presented annually at the Criminal Justice Recognition Ceremony to a second-year Camosun College Criminal Justice Program student, who has achieved excellence in the program.

To be eligible to apply for the Sterling Pacific Investigations Criminal Justice Scholarship, applicants *must*:

- be successfully completing the second and final year of the Criminal Justice Program.
- have attained a minimum GPA of 6.0 (B+).
- demonstrate leadership in student or faculty-sponsored activities.
- participate within the Criminal Justice community in a voluntary capacity.

Note: Recognition of this award will be presented at the Criminal Justice Recognition Ceremony held annually in April. Proof of acceptance from an accredited university indicating continued studies toward the completion of an undergraduate degree is required before the award can be granted.
