CRITERIA FOR ELIGIBILITY

Students must apply for this award.

The Charlotte Bronte Award acknowledges academic achievement in English and is awarded to a student who has written an outstanding research paper for a Camosun College English 150 class.

To be eligible to apply for the Bronte Award, students *must*:

- submit a research paper. The submission must be a Camosun College English 150 course assignment completed in the current academic year. The essay may be slightly revised in response to an instructor's suggestions. Criteria used in the decision include the quality of the academic challenge, the originality of the student's insights, excellence in writing, and appropriate use of M.L.A. documentation.
- submit a clean, typed document and include a title page.
- complete and submit an application form available from the Arts & Science office (F104).
