CRITERIA FOR ELIGIBILITY

Students must apply for this award.

The Emily Bronte Award acknowledges academic achievement and is awarded to a student who has written an outstanding essay of literary analysis for a second-year Camosun College literature course.

To be eligible to apply for the Emily Bronte Award, students must

- submit an essay of literary analysis. The submission must be a Camosun College course assignment completed in the current academic year for a second-year literature course. The essay may be slightly revised in response to an instructor's suggestions. Criteria used in the decision include the quality of the academic challenge, the originality of the student's insights, and excellence in writing.
- submit a clean, typed document with a separate title
- complete and submit an application form available from the Arts & Science office (F104).
