### CRITERIA FOR ELIGIBILITY

#### *Students must apply for this award.*

*This award recognizes a student from the Environmental Technology Co-operative program who has demonstrated a strong commitment to their intended profession.*

**The Air and Waste Management Association Co-operative Education Continuing Student Award is awarded to a student who:**

- Has successfully secured a Co-op placement
- Has demonstrated a strong commitment and positive attitude towards Co-op by actively participating in the Co-op process, including pro-active job search, timely submission of resume and covering letters and participating in Co-op seminars
- Has demonstrated a strong commitment to their profession through involvement in extracurricular activities related to Environmental Technology
- Is willing to stand as the AWMA student liaison representative during the duration of their studies in the Environmental Technology Program
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**Selection:** Interested students will apply for this award by submitting a resume and covering letter outlining their commitment to professional activities and a willingness to stand as the AWMA student liaison representative for the duration of their studies in the Environmental Technology Program. Students must submit a 1-page essay that explains what they have gained from participating in the Co-op process up to this point in their studies. Students must submit a resume, covering letter, and Co-op essay to the Co-op Office by June 15. Selection will be made by the Co-op Coordinator in conjunction with the Program Chair, and with the approval of an AWMA representative.
