# THE GRANT L. AND BRETT FISHER MEMORIAL AWARD

### CRITERIA FOR ELIGIBILITY

***Students must apply for this award.***

*The Grant L. and Brett Fisher Memorial Award was established by the family of Grant Fisher, the first President of Camosun College, to honour their son Brett, who, as a teenager, was tragically killed in a bicycle-car accident. The award recognizes the strong academic achievements and the extracurricular accomplishments of a Camosun College Preparatory student.*

**To be eligible to apply for The Grant L. and Brett Fisher Memorial Award, applicants will:**

- Have successfully completed a minimum of seven courses in the past academic year. At least five of these courses are to be from the College Preparatory Program.
- Have attained a minimum GPA of 6.0 (B+).
- Have a documented record of service to the Camosun College community or the community at large. This is a significant component of the award.
- Submit a short statement describing your community service as well as your academic program and career goals (200 words, typed, double-spaced).
- Complete and submit an application form available from the Arts & Science Office (F104A).
