# TED ADKIN MEMORIAL AWARD

### CRITERIA FOR ELIGIBILITY

#### *Students must apply for this award.*

*This award recognizes a student in the College Preparatory Program or first-year University Transfer who has been away from formal academic studies for at least three years prior to attending Camosun and has strong academic standing in at least six credit courses including one of MATH 137, 105, 107 or 115.*

#### **The Ted Adkin Memorial Award is awarded to a student who:**

- Is a College Preparatory or first-year Arts & Science student who has been away from formal academic studies for at least three years prior to attending Camosun College.
- Has successfully completed at least six credit courses, at least four of which are part of the College Preparatory Program.
- Has completed at least one of the following courses: MATH 137, MATH 105, MATH 107 or MATH 115.
- Has a minimum GPA of 7.0 (A-).
- Has not been a previous recipient of this award.
- Submitted a brief statement describing their background, academic program, career goals and interests (200 words, typed, double-spaced).
- Completed and submitted an application form available from the Arts & Science Office (F104).
