The Elementary Education Mathematics Award is awarded to a student who:

- Has successfully completed all requirements for admission to the 2nd year of the Elementary Education program at the University of Victoria with a minimum GPA of 7.0 (A-).
- Has achieved a superior standing in MATH 112 and MATH 113.
- Submitted a brief statement (200 words) describing their career goals and experience (work-related or volunteer) with elementary school children.
- Completed and submitted an application form available from the Arts & Science Office, F104.
