CRITERIA FOR ELIGIBILITY

Students must apply for this award.

This award honours Leo Neufeld, the former head of the Mathematics Department at Camosun College for more than 25 years. It is presented annually to a Camosun mathematics student for outstanding academic achievement in mathematics, particularly Linear Algebra.

The Leo Neufeld Linear Algebra Award is awarded to a student who:

- Has achieved a high academic standing in at least four mathematics courses at Camosun, two of which will include MATH 110 and 111. Preference will be given to a first year mathematics student.
- Submitted a short statement (200 words) describing their background, interests and academic and career goals.
- Completed and submitted an application form available from the Arts & Science Office (F104A).
