- Has achieved a minimum of A- in both MATH 218 and 219.
- Has successfully completed a minimum of four second year university transferable courses at Camosun.
- Preference will be given to those who may pursue further studies in statistics.
- Has not been a previous recipient of this award.
- Submitted a brief statement (200 words, typed, double-spaced) describing their background, academic program, career goals and interests.
- Completed and submitted an application form available from the Arts & Science Office, F104.
