CRITERIA FOR ELIGIBILITY

No applications are required or requested.

Mrs. Goolden established this award in 1978. Mrs. Goolden was one of the founders of the Victoria Conservatory of Music in 1964, and her desire was that students who graduate from the conservatory program be recognized and given some encouragement to proceed in their chosen careers.

Candidates for the Mrs. A. Massy Goolden Award are nominated by the Victoria Conservatory of Music Faculty and/or Department Heads, and the recipient is selected by the Artistic Directorate.

The award is presented to the graduating student who has:

- Attained academic excellence in the Diploma in Music Program as demonstrated by outstanding GPA across a full-time program;
- Shown evidence of exceptional capacity to succeed in the field of music;
- Demonstrated outstanding potential as a performer and teacher of music;
- Made a positive contribution to the Victoria Conservatory of Music and its artistic work.
