ASIA-PACIFIC STUDIES AWARD

CRITERIA FOR ELIGIBILITY

Students must apply for this award.

The Asia-Pacific Studies Award is presented to a student registered in Asia-Pacific Studies who will be studying in an educational institution in the Asia Pacific Region, and who has successfully completed two semesters of study of an Asian language, prior to departure. Preference will be given to students who demonstrate a commitment to future study and/or employment involving the Asia-Pacific region.

To be eligible to apply for this award, applicants must:

- have completed at least one Asia-Pacific course.
- be intending to further Asia Pacific studies abroad, and must include either:
 - a) a letter of acceptance from an institution verifying registration into a program to pursue further Asia-Pacific Studies, including Asian language studies, *or* any discipline with Asia-Pacific focus, *or*
 - b) a brief essay describing academic and career goals in Asia Pacific Studies (200 words, typed, double space)
- have completed two semesters of study of an Asian language (Japanese or Chinese).
- have attained a high GPA.
- complete and submit an application form available from the Arts & Science office (F104).
