Permanent Residents and Canadian Citizens

Steps to apply and register

STEP 1 Check your prerequisite status

You must be 19 years of age or older / meet the prerequisites for each course, OR take an English language assessment to help us place you at the correct level / bring your legal documents

If you are a Permanent Resident (Landed Immigrant), or a Canadian Citizen and **do not** meet the prerequisites, go to step 2

If you are a Permanent Resident (Landed Immigrant), or a Canadian Citizen and **do** meet the prerequisites, go to step 3

STEP 2 Make an appointment for the placement test

If you have studied English as a Second Language (ESL) less than two years or if you are unsure if you have the prerequisites

- contact the Basic ESL Assessment & Registration

If you have studied ESL longer than two years

- apply online through ApplyBC at camosun.ca/apply
- contact the Assessment Centre

STEP 3 Apply and register

If you are placed at ELD 03 to 06 levels

contact the Basic ESL Assessment and Registration office to apply and register

If you are placed at ELD 07 to 09 levels

apply online through ApplyBC at camosun.ca/apply (the BC Postsecondary Application Service - *recommended*)
or download an application form (pdf) to apply by mail or in person
Completed forms can be dropped off at Enrolment Services.
