
Q: What are x-rays?



A: X-Rays are a type of radiation that when transmitted through a body or object, produces an image of what is inside!

Q: What are x-rays used for?





A: X-rays are used to help physicians diagnose and treat disease and injury.

What is Medical Radiography?

- It is the art and science of producing medical images using x-radiation (film and digital)
- A Medical Radiation Technologist produces images that a radiologist interprets to aid in diagnosing a patient
- Prepares graduates for advanced training and education in imaging specialties such as CT, Breast Imaging, Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI)

Role of the Radiographer

As part of their professional duty, technologists:

- EXPLAIN procedures to patients.
- ANSWER questions as fully as possible.
- CONTRIBUTE to patient education.
- COMFORT patients and provide emotional support.
- POSITION patients and equipment correctly.
- ENSURE that patient, all staff and visitors are protected from radiation.
- MONITOR patients during the procedure.
- ASSIST the radiologist for angiographs and interventional procedures.
- OPERATE the equipment.



The MRT Program

- □ Intense 24 months of study (no summer breaks!)
- 4 month long terms; 6 terms in total
- Classroom with labs (including simulation) alternating with clinical semesters with online courses
- Students act as surrogate patients to learn positioning techniques as well as interpersonal skills
- □ Classes run 5 days/week, often from 0830 1730 hrs

Clinical Experience

- Clinical placements will be at a variety of sites on Vancouver Island
- Three different clinical sites over the three clinical terms
- There is no guarantee that students will receive their preferred placements
- Students are responsible for providing their own transportation and accommodations while on their clinical placement; keep these costs in mind





Admission Process Overview

- □ Stage 1 − Complete your online application between September 4 - December 14, 2018
- □ Stage 2 Video essay questions, academic assessment test, and interviews February
- Stage 3 Invitation to the program*, clinical site placement, and completion of participation requirements

^{*}you will be asked for a \$175.00 deposit to hold a seat; the deposit goes towards your first semester tuition but is non-refundable if you change your mind

Admission Requirements

- □ English 12 (B = 73%)*
- □ Principles of Math 12 (B 73%)*
- □ Physics 12 (B = 73%)*
- □ Biology 12 (B = 73%)*

It is recommended that the academic courses be completed within the last 5 years

 Academic admission requirements 'In progress' at the document submission deadline will be considered, provided official transcripts are received by May 17, 2019. 'In progress' requirements are considered a "B" for interview GPA ranking purposes. (worth 50% of your rank)

Admission Requirements

- □ "B = 73%" or higher in an accredited Medical
 Terminology course with a minimum of 60 hours, can be credit or CE
- IMPORTANT FOR INTERVIEW RANKING: A resume with a cover letter outlining relevant work experience and any personal achievements. The cover letter should answer the "essay" question, "How do you see your academic and life experience as preparation for the Medical Radiography Technology program?" (worth 50% of your rank)

Admission Requirements

Required for your online application by January 11, 2019

- A completed Physical Requirements Form (this will be sent to applicants)
- Attend an MRAD Information Session & complete online questionnaire. Be sure you got a survey card!
- 40 hrs volunteer work in a patient related environment (interactive role) e.g. Long-term care - require letter from supervisor confirming 40 hours and responsibilities performed – some health care professionals can use prior work experience

Interview Selection Process

- □ Must have met minimum requirements by January 11, 2019
- □ Up to 40 eligible applicants are invited for an interview session
 - 1. All applications are ranked using GPA Calculation of the four academic requirements.
 - 2. All Resumes are ranked, points are awarded for work history, education, additional (non-clinical) volunteer work, awards, and achievements, hobbies, etc.
 - 3. All Cover Letters are ranked, points are awarded for answers to both sections of the "essay" question.
- Students selected interview are based 50% on GPA calculation and 50% on Cover Letter & Resume ranking
- Interviews only held during Camosun College Reading week

Interview Process

- Up to 40 eligible applicants are invited for an interview session
 - The applicant will watch a selection of short videos. After each video they will be asked to write a short (one two paragraphs) essay on a question relevant to that video
 - 2. The applicant will write a short multiple choice test to assess their knowledge related to the academic admission requirements.
 - 3. The applicant will then participate in four brief interviews which address the applicant's preparedness to enter the program.

Interview Process

- Students selected for 16 seats are based 50% on scores from interview and 50% on academic assessment
- Students with learning accommodations are <u>encouraged to</u>
 <u>DECLARE AND USE</u> them for the <u>admissions process</u>
- Selected students then participate in program site selection for their three practicum placements.
- Following site selection, students pay their deposit to confirm their seat invitation.
 - All applicants on the "same-year waitlist" are encouraged to complete as many of the Program Participation requirements as possible in order to be eligible for a "last-minute" seat during the first week of classes, BE READY!
 - We typically go through the entire waitlist EVERY year!

Program Participation Requirements

- All students must have received a "clear" criminal record check letter from the Ministry of Public Safety and Solicitor General through the College. Any Criminal Record Check done outside the College will NOT be accepted and will result in additional costs to the student.
- Current Standard First Aid and CPR Level C is required prior to the first clinical experience (usually 14-16 hours), with re-cert annually

Program Participation Requirements, cont.

- A mask fit test will be required prior to the first clinical experience, with re-cert annually
- Proof of non-active TB (TB skin test or negative chest x-ray)
- Students are highly recommended to maintain current immunizations as per the Practice Education Guidelines of B.C.
- Hepatitis B vaccination is highly recommended and readily available at local health clinics or through a physician

- \square \$6,438 ÷ 4 Months (per term) = about \$1,610/month


Employment Potential:

Important Dates

- □ December 14, 2018*
 - Closing date for all applications for the 2019 intake
- □ January 11, 2019*
 - Date when proof of all admission requirements will need to be received by the college.
- □ May 17, 2019*
 - Date when your transcripts showing your final academic admission requirements will need to be received by the college if you have provisional acceptance.
