Alumni Resident Artist Contract with Camosun College Visual Arts

An open call to alumni of Camosun College Visual Arts Program for an artist's residency at Camosun College. The criteria for evaluation includes a description of proposed project, itemized list of facility needs and resource expectations, artist's statement, images (with image list) of previous artwork, and CV. All proposals are reviewed by the Department of Visual Arts, Camosun College. The successful applicant will be required to agree to the following conditions listed below.

Responsibility of Artist

- Duration of residency will be three months, during the fall term at Camosun College, Lansdowne campus, Victoria BC
- The resident artist will agree to a walk-through of our facilities/equipment with department members (instructors and technicians) to review the artist's needs and support requirements based on details outlined in their proposal (computer labs, sculpture studio, printmaking studio, photography darkrooms, digital printers, ceramics studio and hand tools/equipment for the duration of the residency). Please note, due to student needs and institutional limitations, these supports may need to be revised during the residency.
- The A-AIR artist will exhibit their work at either Camosun Visual Arts' gallery space or in another gallery space in Victoria BC.
- The A-AIR artist will present an artist's talk at Camosun College during or following the completion of their residency.
- The A-AIR artist will have one afternoon each week, of their choice, for studio visiting hours for the Camosun students and the general public.
- The A-AIR artist gives Camosun College and the Visual Arts Department permission to photograph and publish images of said artist, their process, and completed projects for promotional purposes including but not limited to; the A-AIR archive, department / college websites, and promotional material. The selected artist gives permission to the Visual Arts Department to share these images and information collected during the residency with students, educators, curators, and collectors for educational purposes.

Responsibility of the Visual Arts department

- Grant from the Camosun College Visual Arts Department in the form of a cheque for the amount of (\$2500.00) will be issued to the artist upon commencement of the residency at Camosun College Visual Arts.
- Camosun College agrees to provide a walk-through of our facilities/equipment with the artist and instructors and technicians to confirm the residency artist's request for access to computer labs, sculpture studio, printmaking studio, photography darkrooms, digital printers, ceramics studio and hand tools/equipment for the duration of the residency. Please note, due to student needs and institutional limitations, these supports may need to be revised during the residency.
- The AIR program will support, promote, photograph, and publish information about the artist and their work during the course of the A-AIR residency.
