Criteria	<p>Candidates must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ demonstrate effort in attendance, quality of work, and display a personal commitment to their schooling ▶ show significant personal academic achievement by making progress in meeting their academic goals (where the student started in their studies and where they are currently in the process of meeting their own goals should be considered) ▶ overcome significant obstacles (personal, social, or institutional) in pursuing their education ▶ demonstrate involvement with and concern for their peers ▶ spend a minimum of one term in the academic upgrading (ABE) program
