### Eligible Students

Full-time college prep students in at least one advanced or provincial English, Math or ELD course

### Eligibility Period

Current 12-month period, May 1–April 30

### Deadline

March 25<sup>th</sup> annually

### Award Value

\$500

### Criteria

Candidates must:

- ▶ be a full-time (9+ hrs/wk) College Preparatory student
- ▶ plan to continue to a post secondary program of studies
- ▶ have a high standing of achievement
- ▶ demonstrate service to the College community or community at large
