Eligibility Period	Current 12-month period, May 1–April 30
Deadline	March 25 th annually
Award Value	Varies
Criteria	<p>ELD faculty must submit an ELD candidate's paragraph/essay as follows:</p> <p>03_ - 06_ level paragraphs:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">▶ must be written as part of the course requirements▶ should show skill in incorporating the use of the specified rhetorical mode(s) and be written as an in-class assignment▶ should show clearly written support for a well-stated topic sentence▶ may incorporate revisions based on instructor comments, but all writing must have been done by the student. <p>07_/09_ level essays:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">▶ must be a major essay written as part of the course requirements▶ must be written as an in-class assignment and it should show skill in the use of writing and/or analytic techniques as specified in the assignment (e.g. techniques may include rhetorical mode(s), literary analysis, etc.)▶ should show well-written support for a clearly stated thesis▶ may incorporate revisions based on instructor comments, but all writing must have been done by the student
