<b>Eligibility Period</b>	Current 12-month period, May 1–April 30
<b>Deadline</b>	March 25 <sup>th</sup> annually
<b>Award Value</b>	Varies
<b>Criteria</b>	<p>Candidates must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▶ successfully graduate from the ETP program and demonstrate an ability to apply acquired skills in a work environment</li> <li>▶ demonstrate motivation/determination to face the challenge of their lives</li> <li>▶ demonstrate sensitivity and concern for the lives of others</li> <li>▶ demonstrate a willingness to share what their life may have to offer to colleagues, associates, workmates, family and others with whom they may interact</li> </ul>
