"C+" or higher in English 12 or English 12 First Peoples; or a "C" or higher in [ENGL 092](#) and [094](#), or [ENGL 092](#) and [096](#), or [ENGL 142](#), or [ELD 092](#) and [094](#), or [ELD 097](#); or [assessment](#).

Math Requirements:

Many first year Business courses require Math as a prerequisite (a "C" in Principles of Math 11, or Pre-calculus 11, or Foundations of Math 11, or Applications of Math 12, or MATH 137, or [MATH 073](#); or "C+" in MATH 135 or [MATH 072](#)).
