What is Dual Credit?

DOUBLE CREDIT

Students earn secondary and post secondary credits while completing a post secondary course or program, tuition-free



SMOOTH TRANSITION

Enables secondary students to begin their transition to post secondary education and future employment

What is a SIP Dual Credit Transition Program?

- ❖ A Camosun College **course or program** that leads to a post secondary credential (certificate, diploma or degree)
- ❖ A dual credit transition program can start in **grade 11 or 12**, and help you transition into a **specific occupation**

Can **YOU** be a Dual Credit student?



Students are able to participate in a dual credit transition program if they meet the following **eligibility requirements**:

- ✓ Registered in a partnering school district (SD61, 62, 63, 64, 79)
- ✓ School Age (talk with your career coordinator for more details)
- ✓ The selected course/program is part of a educational plan that starts in grade 11 or 12 and leads towards a specific occupation

NEXT STEPS:

- ❖ Talk with your **career coordinator or counsellor** about your **interests, goals and plans** for the future (it's okay if you don't have it all planned out)
- ❖ **Determine a course or program that's right for you** – ensure you have the pre-requisites, you're ready for the commitment and that the appropriate supports are set in place for you to be successful
- ❖ Complete a **SIP Application Package**



Other ways to EXPLORE & get CONNECTED:

In addition to supporting dual credit pathways, SIP supports youth transitions in a variety of ways:

- ❖ **Work Experience & Apprenticeship** opportunities
 - ❖ **Construction Ready** project with the Construction Foundation of BC
- ❖ Collaborate with **VIATeC** – Vancouver Island Advanced Technology Council to promote tech careers
- ❖ Work with **Seaspan & Victoria Shipyards** to promote trades career pathways
- ❖ Collaborate with the **Marine Industry** – (DND, BC Ferries, Recreational Marine sector, etc) to promote marine careers
