SIP SUMMER PROGRAMS 2018

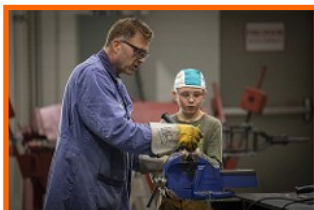
