Who is a Joiner?

Joiners build, repair and re-style wooden furniture, cabinets, fixtures and other products. **A Joiner is designated as a Cabinet-maker under the Inter-provincial Red Seal program.**

What to expect?

This blended program incorporates time spent in your high school woodworking program with college-level instruction and industry work experience placements.

Located at our Interurban campus, this full-time program is 6 weeks long. Classes are scheduled for 5 days a week, 6 hours each day. Your typical day includes theory and lectures in the classroom, with the majority of your time in the shop getting hands-on training.



How much will it cost?

The cost of your Camosun tuition will be covered by the school district. You will be responsible for the [application fee](#), textbooks, and any personal safety gear or other supplies that may be required.
