ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT

Purpose / Rationale

All individuals share the responsibility for protecting the environment. The purpose of this policy is to guide the College's decision-making with respect to this responsibility.

Scope / Limits

- 1. This policy applies to all members of the College community.
- 2. This policy is subject to the laws related to the environment and to other laws of general application.

Principles

- 1. The College is committed to establishing and maintaining high standards of environmental stewardship that protect natural resources and minimize environmental impact.
- 2. To realize this commitment the College will:
 - a) include environmental factors in planning decisions;
 - b) minimize energy and water use;
 - c) minimize waste generation and pollution;
 - d) minimize car dependency;
 - e) establish and/or maintain recycling and other environmental programs;
 - f) ensure proper management and use of hazardous chemicals;
 - g) conduct periodic environmental audits; and
 - h) comply with or exceed appropriate environmental regulation and standards, including meeting LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) standards in all new building construction.
