

Students can also take extra courses ("Electives") in **Grammar**, **Pronunciation**, and **Vocabulary**

Successful completion of level 09 is equivalent to Grade 12 English – then you can enrol in most Camosun programs.

Lower ELD levels satisfy entry to some Camosun programs: Health Care Assistant, Trades, etc.



Flexible Schedules

BESL level courses (ELD 01 - 05):

- Start in September, January, and May
- 15-week courses
- Choose:
 - part-time (10 hours per week)
 - full-time (20 hours per week)
- Morning / afternoon / online evening courses may be available



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Flexible Schedules

English for Academic Purposes level courses (ELD 06 - 07 - 09):

• 7-week full-time courses



• 14/15-week part-time courses



Benefits of 7-week Courses

- More start dates during the year
- More flexibility for students
- Complete a course in 7 weeks
- Intensive focus on one course at a time



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Costs

- Tuition-free for Canadian citizens, permanent residents, and protected persons
