## Early Learning and Care Diploma Apply Now! to the New Online Delivery: Program Starts May 2024 ~Open to Students Across BC & Yukon~

Register now for this two-year ELC Diploma for students across BC & Yukon!
Most courses are "Blended" delivery: a combination of evening *synchronous* online classes (weekly scheduled), *asynchronous* online classes (weekly content and discussions without scheduled times), and a required in-person weekend intensive once per semester at Camosun's Interurban Campus in Victoria.

This delivery is a great option for students who are working in the field, prefer online classes, and want to remain in their home community for practicum placements. Throughout this online blended delivery, students will be required to have required technology and to participate in synchronous online discussions, videos, and submit recordings of their practice in practicum (more information on <a href="Camosun's Online Learning">Camosun's Online Learning</a>).
