FLEXIBLE LEARNING

Providing opportunities for students to exercise choice, between flexible options within their learning experience, helps to empower them and assist them in developing organizational, prioritizing and decision-making skills.

Suggestions:

- 1. Providing the option to choose the "best two out of three grades" for assignments or quizzes.
- 2. Offering students the choice of setting their own due dates for assignments, from options provided.
- 3. Providing options for students to weight the percentages of assignments, contributing to the final grade in the course.
- 4. Encourage and solicit feedback from students throughout the semester- through survey or anonymous class comment.
- 5. Provide students with lecture notes and/or PowerPoint slides or video portions ahead of class time, so for class time can be devoted to discussion and application of learning.
- 6. Provide alternative forms of contact with the instructor office hours for example Skype, group office hours, web-conferencing via D2L.
