
WIL Experiences

Alternate between full-time studies and full-time paid work with one or more employers. You will need to complete at least two work terms (minimum 420 hours each) to graduate with a "Co-op Education" designation.

Practicum

Observe working professionals on the job and practice the skills you have learned in class. You will need to complete a specific number of supervised practice hours (unpaid) to fulfill the practicum requirements for your program.



Internship

Engage in full-time studies and full-time or part-time work, which may be paid or unpaid. You will need to complete at least one work term (minimum 300 hours) to graduate with an "Internship" designation.







Admissions



General admission requirements for Camosun's academic programs are as follows:*

If you are 17 or 18 years old** High School Graduation is mandatory.

If you are 19 years old or older** High School Graduation is highly recommended for prerequisite purposes (unless required by the specific program admission requirements).

**at the start of your first academic term. If you are a High School Graduate and 16 years old or younger, please contact us.

English proficiency (one of): ***

- » Camosun ELD 092 and 094, or ELD 097 with final grade of C or better
- » Recognized ESL pathway partner certificate
- » BC High School English 12 or English Studies 12 or equivalent with final grade of C+ or better
- » IELTS (Academic) score of 6.0 overall (no sub-score less than 6.0)
- » TOEFL iBT score of 78 overall (no sub-score less than 19)
- » PTE Academic score of 54 overall (no sub-score less than 50)
- » Duolingo English Test (DET) score of 110 for General Admission to most Certificate and Diploma programs, and Bachelor of Business Administration programs (exceptions: Nursing and certain other Healthrelated programs). Score of 115 for admission to Post-Degree programs (all majors) and Degree programs offered by Centre for Sport and Exercise Education.

1. Apply Online

Submit online application through Education PlannerBC (pay \$100 non-refundable application fee). Make sure to submit supporting documents as well.

Supporting documents may include:

- Transcripts (high school/post-secondary). Scanned copies of official documents are acceptable to submit with application. Official, sealed transcripts must be received by Camosun International. If a supporting document is in a language other than English, please provide a certified English translation.
- Proof of English proficiency
- Scanned copy o passport (pages showing photo, personal information, and signature)
- Study Permit or any other Canadian government-issued permit (if applicable)
- Program-specific documents (if applicable)



2. Receive letter of eligibility

Once your application has been reviewed, and if we determine we can offer you a seat in the program, you will receive a Letter of Eligibility and details regarding your Tuition and Fee Deposit. You must pay the tuition and fee deposit in order to receive the Letter of Acceptance, which is required to apply for a study permit (and entry visa if necessary). The Tuition and Fee Deposit is non-refundable and non-transferable.*

3. Receive letter of acceptance and Provincial Attestation Letter

Submit your application for your study permit (and entry visa if necessary) to Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada (IRCC), and make your travel arrangements to come to Canada in time for the New Student Orientation.
