

We're here to support you every step of the way. Wishing you a productive and successful December! Don't hesitate to reach out if you have any questions or need assistance.





Apply for MSP Insurance

Have you applied for the BC Medical Services Plan (MSP)?

It's important to register for MSP as soon as you arrive in British Columbia to ensure continuous health coverage.

If you haven't yet applied, please do so before your guard.me insurance expires.

Apply for Bus pass (Umo)

New students can get their U-Pass benefit code 10 days before the term starts, <u>but it</u> <u>will only become active on</u> <u>the first day of classes.</u>

You can use either the Umo app or a reloadable Umo card for your bus rides.

Apply for Camosun ID card

Your Camosun ID card is essential for borrowing books, accessing facilities, and getting discounts.

New students can request their ID 10 days before classes start, provided they're registered in at least one credit course.

Pick up your card at the library the next day with a government-issued ID.

Are you planning to apply for the Post-Graduation Work Permit (PGWP)?



You might be eligible to live and work in Canada after graduating from your program.

Make sure to <u>check your</u> <u>eligibility</u> and <u>prepare your</u> <u>documents</u> in advance.

You will need **two specific documents** from us for your PGWP application.
