Dental Hygiene, Bachelor of Science

Upgrade your dental hygiene diploma to a Bachelor of Science in Dental Hygiene (BScDH). With the equivalent of one additional year of study, you can become a Dental Hygiene Practitioner (DHP) and be licensed to own/operate a private dental hygiene business.

This completion program follows a three-year dental hygiene diploma. Core classes are taught online. Elective classes may be taught face-to-face, online or in a blended format depending on your selection.

Follow your own muse to develop your powers of creative expression and the technical skills needed to thrive as a writer.

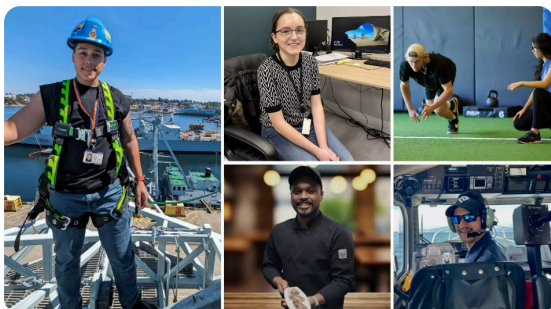
