

School of Business Programs

We offer more than 20 business programs, including degrees, post-degree diplomas, certificates, diplomas, and university transfer courses.

There are numerous route possibilities that can lead to a successful career in business. For instance, a student can start by completing a Business Administration certificate, then pursue a diploma, and later obtain their degree. This approach allows them to work between each stage, gaining three credentials, all while spending the same amount of time in class as a student who proceeds directly to a bachelor's degree.

University Transfer, Business

If you're planning to start at Camosun and then transfer to another post-secondary institution's Business program, you can complete one or two years of general studies through Camosun's University Transfer program. Be sure to consult the BC Transfer Guide, connect with the institution you plan to transfer to, and meet with one of our Academic Advisors to ensure you're on track!

Associate of Arts, Economics

This two-year, 20-course program provides a strong foundation in economics, statistics, science, and English, along with elective courses to customize your education.

As a graduate, you can choose to continue your studies or pursue a career in academia, banking, government, business, international development, or research organizations.
