## Requirements

Exchange students are welcome to make their selection from the here listed modules, as long as module requirements are met (please see the module descriptions). Combining modules from different degree programmes is also possible. If in doubt, please contact us: [international.business@bfh.ch](mailto:international.business@bfh.ch)

## Time Table

We do not allow students to take modules that overlap in time. Please use the time table template as an aid to create your individual time table. Sometimes the same module is taught in several different classes or groups, so you have the possibility to choose the class that best fits your time table.

## Limited Spots

Modules have limited spots available. These spots will be filled on a first come, first served basis. Therefore we recommend you return your module selection as soon as possible.

## Min / Max Credits

Every incoming student must at least enroll into modules with a total of 12 ECTS. The maximum amount of ECTS credits are 32 ECTS. Students are responsible for checking and keeping to any possible specific module selection-related and other requirements their own home university may have for accrediting an exchange semester.

## Workload

1 ECTS = 30 working hours. This includes contact lessons, self-study, project work and exam preparation. ## Group Projects

If group projects or presentations are the form of assessment in a module, note that your attendance will be required at designated dates and times. Group projects are very common at the BFH Business School. It is important that each student participates in group work on an equal basis.

## Exam Period

Final exams will take place on campus between 16 January and 4 February 2023. Please make sure to be available for the exams in Bern.

## Module Changes

Module changes are only possible during the first two semester weeks. Drop-outs need no further explanation. Drop-ins into new modules are accepted in exceptional cases and upon request only, for example in the event of unexpected time table clashes or unmet requirements (required previous knowledge) in a module.
