Next Steps

Your application is welcome at any time. Camosun admits qualified applicants on a first-come, first-served basis for September, January and May starts.

There is a non-refundable application fee and you may apply online, by mail, by fax or in person. You will find all the details online at camosun.ca/apply

Once the application process is complete and you have met all the admission requirements*, you will be asked to pay a non-refundable registration deposit which will be applied toward your tuition fees. By paying a non-refundable registration deposit, you are confirming that you will be registering in courses in the next semester.

We encourage you to apply well before the semester in which you want to start a program. This will provide you with the best opportunity to create a suitable timetable.

*Most business programs include courses that require Math 11 as a prerequisite. You may enter a program without math but you must successfully complete Principles of Math 11 or equivalent or successfully complete Camosun's math assessment in or before your first semester of study.
